PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

The cable television industry in the country is currently in the process of going digital from the old analog system. As such, it is important for the Authority to determine the requirement of new cable television operators in the country before issuing new cable television (CATV) operator's licenses. Until all CATV Operators in the country are digitized and interconnected with its Multi-Service Operator, it is difficult for the Authority to establish this requirement since the actual no. of subscribers covered by the CATV Operators cannot be fully validated.

Therefore, the Authority would like to notify the general public that the licensing of new cable television operators in the country is hereby suspended till further notice until all the existing cable operators are fully digitized and the Authority is in a position to ascertain the requirement of new CATV operators. However, the Authority may make exceptions for applications to cover areas which have not been covered by any cable television operators.
