Physical verification on Mobile Network Connectivity to carry out Rural Communication Programme (RCP) Phase VII

The RCP was initiated in 2009 to provide mobile network connectivity in unconnected villages across different Dzongkhags and Gewogs. Till date, the Authority has completed 5 Phases of RCP with the RCP VI Phase ongoing which is planned to be completed in September 2022.

The main objective of these programmes is to achieve the Royal Government's objective of "Universal Connectivity" of communication services in the country. The programmes were funded from Universal Service Fund (USF) and implemented through 'minimum subsidy' bidding process and on cost sharing basis.

The Authority carried out physical verification for unconnected Households to include in Future Rural Communication Programme (RCP) projects. Punakha, Bumthang, Haa, Wangduephodrang, Samtse and Sarpang Dzongkhags are physically verified and the findings are as follows:
