1. Background

The Authority collects the monthly system generated Mobile Operating Support System (OSS) report from the Telecom Operators and does reviews on the average Mobile Quality of Service (QoS). Based on the system generated Mobile OSS reports, the Authority decides the locations of physical verification or a drive test and carries out the Mobile QoS drive test to monitor and report the QoS regularly. The Mobile OSS report contains the mobile QoS for both voice and data services which are based on and measured through the various parameters of key performance indicators (KPI) of Mobile services of the 20 dzongkhags.

These OSS reports contain both operator's averaged Operation Support system (OSS) reports for the month of April 2025.

2. Findings

The results and findings of OSS system generated reports submitted by both the telecom operators are mentioned below:

3. Analysis

- a. The download throughput for 3G is within the set standard for both the telcos. The Upload throughput for 3G of both the telcos is **below** the standard in all Dzongkhags for both the telcos. However, since there are not many users and 3G is being phased out and wherever 3G is available the 4G is also available, **the issue does not have much implications.**
- b. The download throughput for 4G of both the telcos is **within** the set standard in all Dzongkhags.
- c. The Upload throughput for 4G of BTL is **within** the standard **except for Dagana and Lhuntse**. The Upload throughput for 4G of TICPL is **not within** the set standard in **all Dzongkhags** except for Bumthang, Mongar, Paro, Sarpang, S/Jongkhar, Thimphu, Trongsa, Wangdue Phodrang and Zhemgang.
- d. The Download throughput for 5G of BTL is **within** the standard for all Dzongkhags. The Download throughput for 5G of TICPL is **below** the standard in **all** Dzongkhags except for Dagana and Zhemgang.
- e. The Upload throughput for 5G of both the telcos is below the standard for all Dzongkhags.
- f. BTL has mentioned that for 5G, the low PS success rate in Thimphu and high PS Drop Rate at Sarpang, Trongsa, Pemagatshel, and Mongar is being addressed. The Authority may seek clarification on what caused the issue for 5G.
